Halocorder can be viewed through an analogue channel on a Halocam. Simple key actions on industry-standard CCTV controllers toggle between live / playback without interrupting recording. Navigable timeline indicates recorded events and facilitates easy navigation by zooming and panning the timeline or stepping between events. Use VCAMs on the recorded footage and PTZ retrospectively with 7x zoom.

360° remote viewing

Haloviewer enables remote viewing of live Halocam or recorded Halocorder footage. Haloviewer runs on a standard Windows PC and connects to the recorder over TCP/IP, enabling viewing on a local or remote PC. Hi-res video can be downloaded and archived. Self-contained CDs/DVDs can be generated which include a simple interface for retrospective playback and complete ePTZ of the surveillance footage.

seamless system integration



Halocorder can be easily integrated into an existing analogue installation with a single connection to a Halocam. A more effective integration can be achieved by connecting the TCP/IP link to the Halocorder to facilitate remote viewing and archival via Haloviewer. A unified DVR interface may be achieved by integrating Grandeye's SDK pack into the DVR to offer more advanced functionality (such as long-term archival).
